



Health & Safety Reps 5-day Course

Accredited by the OS & H Commission (Work Safe)

The aim of this course is give Safety and Health Representatives and, if appropriate supervisors, managers and others, the basic knowledge and skills to effectively perform their roles and functions under the legislation. The ultimate objective is to assist in improving safety and health in Western Australian workplaces.

The course applies to all elected Safety and Health Representatives including those from the mining and petroleum industry. It is designed to enable elected Safety and Health Representatives to effectively represent their fellow employees in matters relating to occupational safety and health at the workplace.

Course materials and supporting activities are structured to ensure that everyone attending can participate and contribute.

Time: 8.30am - 4.00pm, daily.

Cost: \$650.00

What to bring: We will be doing a site inspection during the course so you will need closed in footwear. You will be advised when to bring your P.P.E. (Personal Protective Clothing). Industry Information that relates directly to your workplace may be able to be included into the course content if time permits.

Key Topics: Legislation, Sources of information, Negotiation and issuing PINs, Communication and Representation skills, Systems approach to managing hazards, Workplace inspections, Accident/incident investigation, Establishing and reviewing workplace procedures, Safety and Health Committees, Role of the Safety and Health Representative, Specific hazards.
